Dear Members of the Randolph Community:

Last week on Thursday, Oct. 31, a state elected official and leadership with the Philadelphia Federation of Teachers (PFT) visited the Randolph campus. During their tour, they viewed multiple locations, including the Construction CTE Shop, AutoBody CTE Shop and various classrooms.

Since last Thursday, I have been working closely with the District's Facilities and Maintenance departments to address concerns that were raised during the visit.

The Facilities and Maintenance team visited Randolph on the morning of Friday, November 1 and inspected the building for water intrusion. Upon inspection of the roof they identified multiple power ventilating units where the covers were dislodged or missing, and worked quickly to solve the issue by using tarps to seal out the rain. The Facilities and Maintenance team is also working to replace the current units with new units.

In addition, roofers inspected the roof and identified and repaired seven locations on the roof membrane that were damaged. The District's Capital Programs Department is looking into next steps for repair or replacement.
